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*The Agricultural Reform Institutions of the Kingdom of Yugoslavia (1919–1941)*

*Summary*

In the Kingdom of Yugoslavia (the Kingdom of Serbs, Croats and Slovenians) agricultural reforms measures were implemented, the application of which was especially insisted upon from 1919 to 1929, and from that time up to 1941 as measures aimed at resolving the difficult situation in the field existing at the time. Several state institutions were entrusted with the implementation of the reform in the KY (KSCS), from ministries (the Ministry for Agricultural Reform from 1919 until 1929 when it ceased to exist and its mandate transferred to the Ministry of Agriculture), to regional agricultural directorates with district agricultural offices, to county agricultural boards. The history of each of these institutions have not been reviewed in this work, merely the situation and contents of archive material containing archive material from several state institutions that dealt with the implementation of the agricultural reform in the KY (KSCS) 1919–1941.
