*The Visit of Josip Broz Tito to Ethiopia 11–24 December 1955*

*Summary*

Yugoslav side thought the visit to Ethiopia as repeatedly constructive. Before all, its diplomacy took the active part in political life in the continent of Africa. Projects for economic cooperation of two states were defined, foreseeing increased engagement of Yugoslav experts. Josip Broz Tito was introduced in detail with the situation in the region and he strengthened already good relation with Tsar Haile Selassie, advised him how to diminish dependence on the West and introduced himself as a politician well-informed about crucial international matters. Yugoslav President took over the role of mediator between Ethiopia and Egypt. Everything above mentioned led Yugoslavia into the “black continent” and enable the first and the most important step for it.
