

75 Years of the Archives of Yugoslavia Program

The Archives of Yugoslavia will mark the significant anniversary of 75 years since its founding on January 21, 2025, starting at 1:00 PM. The event will take place in the amphitheater of the Archives of Yugoslavia.

The program will begin with an address by the Director of the Archives of Yugoslavia, Dr. Milan Terzić, who will briefly present the Archives with an emphasis on its publishing activities.

Following this, there will be a promotion of the latest two publications:

1. A collection of works by Dr. Živko Avramovski, *History of Albania and Serbian/Yugoslav-Albanian Relations 1912–1944*, with a presentation by the author of the introductory study, Dr. Dušan Bojković, Senior Archivist at the Archives of Yugoslavia.
2. A collection of documents *Serbian/Yugoslav-Egyptian Relations 1908–1990*, with an introductory study by Dr. Dragan Bogetić, a member of the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts (SANU). The book will be discussed by Dragan Teodosić, Head of the Department for Publishing Archival Materials and Inter-Archive Cooperation.

The Minister of Culture, Nikola Selaković, is also expected to attend and address the audience.

The event will be accompanied by two exhibitions: one in the entrance hall dedicated to the 75th anniversary of the Archives of Yugoslavia, and another in the exhibition hall dedicated to the World War I memorial heritage in the holdings and collections of the Archives of Yugoslavia, which was opened at the end of last year.

At the end of the official part, the Archives will host a reception for guests and dignitaries in the exhibition hall of the Archives of Yugoslavia.
